

# Behaviour Policy

Minor incidents/one off inappropriate behaviour

Appropriate sanction by Teacher.  
If resolved, no further action

Frequent poor behaviour

Further sanctions are used, Teacher records behaviour—raises a concern  
Parents are informed.  
Deputy head/SENCo involved

Persistent poor behaviour

Parents invited into school to discuss  
Headteacher involved  
Meeting is recorded and targets for improvement agreed  
School—based interventions used  
Behaviour monitored closely

Serious misbehaviour/unresolved behavioural problems

Formal meeting held with parents  
Permission for external agency advice sought  
Record of all behaviour incidents kept on file and communicated to parents  
'Internal Exclusion' used if necessary

Pupil at Risk of Exclusion

Relevant agencies are involved,  
Formal 'Action Plan' with agreed targets put in place  
Regular reviews of behaviour involving child and parents

Serious breach of school rules

Fixed Term/Permanent Exclusion

Appeal Process

Level 1—Examples of minor everyday problems

- Interrupting a teacher
- Attention seeking behaviours
- Fiddling with objects/furniture when asked to listen
- Answering back/ being rude to an adult
- Shouting at others
- Pushing in queues/lines
- Name calling/teasing
- Off task /disturbing others
- Interfering with other children's games

Typical sanctions include

- Apologising
- Loss of privileges
- Time out, move seat/sit close to teacher/ move place in line
- Losing some playtime
- Removed from game/ activity on playground for short time
- No equipment/apparatus/football
- Work in another classroom
- Move name on peg chart

Level 2 –Examples of inappropriate behaviour

- Repetition of level 1 problems
- Spitting, swearing, lying, biting,
- Aggressive behaviour towards others eg kicking, hitting, tripping or other physical contact
- Refusal to follow instructions

Typical sanctions include:

- Apologising / Written apology
- Behaviour chart/ Home School diary
- Loss of privileges
- Losing playtime /lunchtime
- Working in a different classroom
- During lunchtime— referred to a teacher/senior leader
- Internal exclusion

Level 3—Examples of serious misbehaviour

- Repetition of level 2 inappropriate behaviour
- Stealing, bullying, vandalism, racial abuse
- Verbal abuse of staff
- Putting self or others in danger
- Serious aggressive behaviour towards other pupils
- Running away

Typical sanctions include

- Daily monitoring by senior leader— before school, break time, and /or lunchtime
- Working away from the class ( Internal Exclusion)
- Excluded for lunchtime
- Special arrangements made for beginning/end of school day.
- Regular agreed contact with parents to report on behaviour

Level 4 Examples of gross misconduct

- Repeated incidents of level 3 serious misbehaviour
- Threatening a member of staff
- Assaulting a member of staff
- Possession of an object used in a deliberately threatening or dangerous way

Sanctions are:

Fixed Term/Permanent Exclusion
